



## Abstract Submission Deadline: **15.04.2019**

Official language: **English or French (for the Francophonie session).**

## Abstract Submission Information

- » Contributed abstracts may be submitted for **poster or oral presentations**.
- » Abstracts must be submitted in English using a word document with following settings:
  - Page format: A4
  - Margins: top = bottom = 4,5cm; left = right = 4cm
  - Font: **Book Antiqua 11**
- » Notifications on the status (**accepted/oral/poster**) of submitted abstracts will be sent by **08.05.2019**
- » **Registration of the presenting author is mandatory.** In order to ensure inclusion in the final program and in the symposium publications, the presenting author is required to register by **08.05.2019**
- » Accepted abstracts will be published in the **Book of abstracts**.

## Abstract Guidelines

**Authors** (for all authors please use full first name, middle initial(s) and full last name)

- » The name of the presenting author will be bolded.
- » Insert the names of all the additional authors in the order that they should appear in the abstract.
- » Please mark the corresponding author with an asterisk (e.g. Cathy A. Johnson\*).
- » At the end of the abstract text, in a separate line following a blank line, please write an asterisk, followed by the corresponding author email address(es), e.g.: \* cathy.johnson@emaildomain.com
- » Font: **Book Antiqua 11**



## Affiliation/s (Institution/s)

- » Insert institution details and check the author/s associated to that institution. Affiliation (Institution), name and full address of the institution (no, Street. postal code, city, -State, if applicable-country), phone and fax numbers, e-mail.
- » The affiliations will be marked with small letters:  
(<sup>a</sup>Galati University, <sup>b</sup>Bucharest University, <sup>c</sup>London University, ...)
- » Do not repeat identical institution details if they apply to more than one author.
- » Capitalize only the first letters of institutional names.
- » Do not abbreviate Institute, University, etc.
- » Font: **Book Antiqua 11, italic.**

## Title

- » The title must be centred and written in capital letters.
- » Titles should be brief and should specifically describe the content of the paper.
- » Font: **Book Antiqua 12, bold**

## Abstract

- » The abstract should be a brief summary of the major findings of the investigation.
- » The text body should contain min. 250 words and max. 500 words and one figure/table are allowed.
- » Spacing: before (6 pt).
- » Line spacing: single.
- » Font: **Book Antiqua 11** for basic text and **10** for figures and tables.

## Key words

- » 5 words or groups of 2-3 words.

Each abstract will be reviewed and the decision of the Scientific Committee will be communicated to the corresponding author by the **08.05.2019**
